

## **Export Compliance**

A branch of the U.S. Department of Commerce known as the Bureau of Industry and Security regulates exports through the Export Administration Regulations ("EAR"). These regulations spell out export and re-export restrictions on a wide variety of goods, software, and technologies.

The GoSilent Client and SilentEdge Enterprise Server (SEES) are authorized for license exception ENC under section 740.17(A) of the Export Administration Regulations (EAR) and is described in section 740.17(B)(1).

The products may be delivered to most end users worldwide, except to entities or end users in embargoed countries (Cuba, Iran, North Korea, Sudan, Syria) and except for end users who are on the Consolidated Screening List.
